




Monday 1/29	Tuesday 1/30
<p>Please remember to practice sight words and math facts at home with your child! Weather closings/delays make the perfect time to review. Make a memory game with index cards. Hide a few sight words around the house with a reward for words found and read. Check out the iPad app <u>Fry Words</u>, we have been using it during reading centers and the kids love to move through the lists. First graders should know about 100 of the 150 words at this point. Also, the students should be able to complete 20 addition/subtraction facts (answers to 10) within one minute.</p>	<p>In FUNdations we have introduced glued sounds. Our first glued sound was <u>all</u>. It is tapped as one sound.</p> <p>We also learned the floss rule.
